Native American Collage Project

This project is designed for you, the student, to express your **knowledge and feelings** through art. We have studied the U.S. policy towards Indians and have examined in detail the lives of the Cherokees and the Apaches. What have you learned? Show me what you have learned through a collage or some other art medium of your choice.

A **collage** is a collection of pictures and words with a story line theme behind it.

Example 1:

On construction paper, focusing on the Trail of Tears, I would have "Cherokee" in letters cut out; a Native American crying and a picture of the rugged terrain they crossed with many pictures of sad faces.

Cut and paste words describing your **thoughts and feelings**.

Example 2:

I might compare the culture of the Americans with the culture of the Native Americans; and show how their cultures clashed. Cut and paste words describing your **thoughts and feelings**.

Guidelines:

◊ You must have at least **12 words** (thoughts and feelings)

- You must have a least 6 pictures (thoughts and feelings)
- ◊ You must use the construction paper size given.
- ◊ Be neat / Fill up the poster with words and pictures.

This project is designed to be yet another way of assessing your knowledge. Don't stress out, take your time, and show some creativity. If you have any questions, ask. This art project should be a reflection of what you have learned.
